1 **ARTICLE 2** 2 **UFF PRIVILEGES** 3

- 4 2.1 Use of Facilities and Services. Subject to the rules, regulations and policies of the 5 Board and the University, the UFF shall have the right to use the University's facilities 6 for meetings on the same basis as they are available to Affiliated Organizations. (See 7 FPU1.003 Use of University Facilities and Properties, amended on Dec. 6, 2017.) The 8 UFF will not be charged for facility space usage or associated processing fees. 9
- 10 Faculty Assembly Meetings. The UFF shall have the right to address the Faculty 2.2 11 Assembly when properly recognized by the Chair for the purpose of making 12 announcements regarding collective bargaining or any item on the Faculty Assembly's 13 agenda that affects the wages, hours, or other terms and conditions of employment of 14 bargaining unit members. Such recognition shall occur in the same manner for the UFF 15 as it does for other organizations (i.e. Student Government Association) seeking to 16 address the Faculty Assembly for the purpose of making public comments.
- 18 2.3 Other Meetings. UFF may invite faculty to UFF events such as lunches, picnics, 19 gatherings, dinners, and other events as determined by the UFF. 20
- 21 2.4 New Faculty. UFF shall receive notification three times per year (prior to the opening of 22 the fall semester, prior to the opening of the spring semester, and immediately at the 23 conclusion of the spring semester) of new faculty hires including rank and academic year 24 salary. UFF shall be given the opportunity to speak annually at the fall faculty orientation 25 for ten minutes.
 - 2.5 Bulletin Boards. UFF shall have the right to post notices to employees of activities and matters of concern to academic professionals on non-electronic bulletin boards located in areas as mutually agreed upon by UFF and the University. UFF is responsible for removing such postings when appropriate, but in no event shall the postings be left up for more than thirty (30) days. All materials placed on the designated bulletin boards shall bear the date of posting and may be removed by the University after having been posted for a period of thirty (30) days. In addition, such bulletin boards may not be used for election campaigns for public office or exclusive collective bargaining representation.
 - 2.6 Communication. UFF shall have the right to send communications to their members or
